I am solely responsible for not only the design of all projects, but also for administrative, secretarial and professional responsibilities, which include engaging clients and fulfilling the firm's responsibility to them.

As a Project Architect, I was co-responsible for my projects with the firm Principal. On the projects I managed, I worked solely and directly with the firm principal. I was intimately involved in project programming, pricing, permitting, bidding contractors, drawing the construction document set, administering construction, and photographing the completed project. I was the point of contact for clients and for contractors, and acquired experience in cooperating with both. Projects I worked on at David Jameson Architect have garnered national recognition and have earned multiple awards, including a National AIA Honor Award.

While employed at the internationally renowned Office of Peter Zumthor, I performed a variety of tasks expected of an Intern Architect. These tasks included hand crafting models in a variety of materials, both for study and presentation, and drawing, both manually and computer-assisted. I was also given design responsibilities over several small projects in the office, including a family of tables for the Hotel Vals in Switzerland. I was engaged in two design projects under a supervising Project Architect. These were the Dia Center extension in Beacon, New York, and the Pingus Winery in Spain.
